WHEREAS, vision disorders are one of the leading impediments to successful learning in children. These issues can be treated through vision therapy, particularly when diagnosed early; and

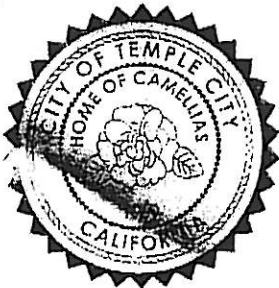


