WHEREAS, as many as one in four school-age children have vision problems; and

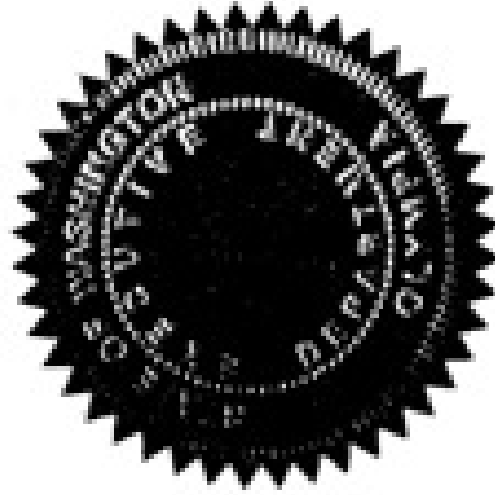
WHEREAS, all children deserve the opportunity to learn and to achieve their full potential; and
